Syllabus for M.A. (Hindi)
Entrance Test Examination 2021-22

Time: 1.30 Hours

Marks: 100

The Entrance Test for M.A. in Hindi Language & Literature will comprise of two parts- Part-A & Part-B.

1. Part-A will consist of 40 objective type multiple choice questions regarding General awareness & Current Affairs related to Hindi Language and Literature, History of Hindi Literature, Poetics, Hindi Poetry, Fiction (Short Stories, Drama and Novels), Literary Genres and Criticism. Each Question contains one mark. There will be negative marking in Part-A with a weightage of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer.
2. Part-B will consist of Subjective type descriptive questions with weightage of 60 marks consisting of 6 questions of 10 marks each. Questions will be based on History of Hindi Literature, Poetics, Poetry, Hindi Fiction (Short Stories, Drama and Novels), Literary Genres i.e. Nibandh & Lalit Nibandh, Vyangya, Sameeksha literary discourse and others.

Note: Admission to the M.A. (Hindi) shall be done on the basis of merit determined by the result of Entrance Test Examination.
